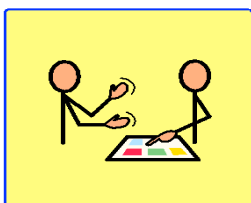


Developing Total Communication Resources

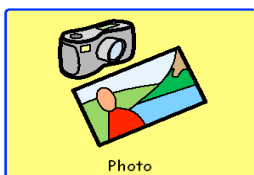
The training session will cover:
